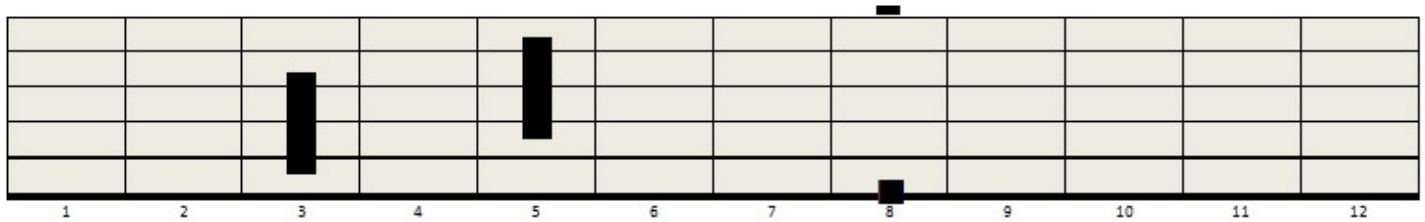

# Capo Combination Chords Chart for "Entirely To Thee"

It is not a requirement to play this song in this manner. However, this is how it was played in the [Prayer Meeting Podcast](#) and the [YouTube video](#). **NOTE: The Guitar is tuned down ONE FULL STEP, so that the notes are d-g-c-f-a-d.**

Furthermore, this guitar neck is comprised of a Cut-capo (fret 3), an Open-G Capo (fret 5), and a Woodie's G-Band Capo (fret 8). The Open-G Capo can be replaced by an upside down Cut Capo. The Woodie's G-Band Capo can be replaced by a Third-Hand or a Spider capo (although playing it will be more difficult. As it stands, this can be played without any fingering and is a B $\flat$ .
